NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the RYA prescriptions and the rules of the relevant Class Association.

1.2 Competitors should note Ogston Sailing Club implement the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be expected to sail in compliance with it. The Charter can be found in the RYA edition of the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, or on the RYA website at www.rya.org.uk/racingrules.

1.3 The event is designated Category C.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 Entry is open to all boats with a valid measurement certificate.

2.2 Entry fees will be £15.00 per boat with a reduced fee of £10 for under 18s.

4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Registration will be held in the clubhouse from 0900 on Sunday 2nd June 2024. Competitor's briefing will be at 11 am.

4.2 Three races are scheduled with the first race warning not before 11.30 on Sunday 2nd June, and subsequent races may be held "back to back" as advised.

5 SCORING

5.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series and there will be one discard when 3 races have been completed.

5.2 The low points system as provided in RRS Appendix A will apply.

6 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

6.1 Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 – Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta.

7 INSURANCE

7.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £5,000,000 for any one accident.

8. Rights to Use Names and Likenesses

8.1. Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority, without payment, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any visual records of, or relating to the event. They also allow their names, age category, club and boat details to be displayed in competitors' lists and in results, both on relevant websites and in publications.

A. Other Information

A.1 Camping is permitted on site. There is no charge for camping, but it must be booked in advance. Please contact vice.commodore@ogstonsc.co.uk to arrange.

A.2 Dogs must be on a lead at all times whilst on site

A.3 A pre-booked lunch will be served after the first race. Please order at registration. Breakfast will be available to buy in the morning.

A.4 OSC have adopted a Swimsuit Policy, therefore when in the changing rooms, please ensure you are covered up even if there is no one else in the room.

A.5 Personal flotation devices are mandatory at all times when on the water, or the jetty.
